**Policy 6317
School Calendar**

The Superintendent of Schools shall annually recommend a school calendar which meets all statutory requirements to the Clinton Board of Education for its review and approval. The Clinton Board of Education may modify school calendars at any time, as it believes appropriate within statutory guidelines.

Academic year calendars recommended to the Board may include the operation of schools on state holidays providing a suitable nonsectarian educational program is held to observe the holiday, except for those holidays that occur in December and January.

The school calendar shall show and identify school days in each school month, the number of school days in each month, legal and local holidays, staff development days, early closing days, vacation periods and other pertinent dates.

The Superintendent shall recommend a school year calendar for the subsequent school year no later than the first regular meeting in October and the Board shall adopt a calendar for the following school year by December. The Board may also consider setting a calendar for multiple school years if it deems it appropriate, and will instruct the Superintendent accordingly.
